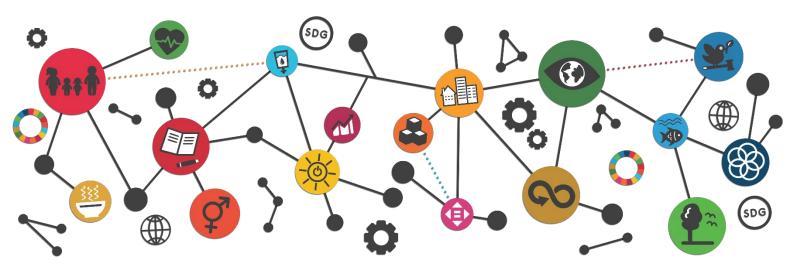

Data recipients	The jury members and competition organizers will have access to the data. For the purpose of transferring the prize money, the following data of the winners will be forwarded to the HSD Finance Department: • First and last name • Address • Bank account details • Reason for payment
Duration of data storage	The personal data submitted for the competition will be stored as long as necessary for the execution, evaluation, and settlement of the competition "Sustainability in Action @HSD". The personal data of the prize winners will be deleted five years after the date of the award ceremony. The personal data of all other participants will be deleted one year after the date of the award ceremony.
Data subject rights	Participants have a right of access to information about the personal data saved, which should also be in a common, structured and machine readable format. During the selection phase, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. If they do not agree to the collection and processing of your data, you will be excluded from the selection process. You are entitled to have inaccurate data corrected and data deleted that are no longer required or for the use of which you have withdrawn your consent. In certain circumstances, you have the right in accordance with Art. 17 of the GDPR to restrict the processing of your saved data.
Right to appeal	You have the right to appeal to the State Commissioner for the Protection of Data and Right of Information of North Rhine-Westphalia (www.ldi.nrw.de) as the supervisory authority for data protection in North Rhine-Westphalia and for Hochschule Düsseldorf – University of Applied Sciences or to the supervisory body in your home country if you are not in Germany.
Contractual obligation	By signing the form, participants consent to the further processing of the collected data for the purposes mentioned above. If you do not agree to the collection and processing, you will not be able to participate in the competition, i.e. you will be excluded from the selection process. Therefore, you can no longer withdraw your consent once the selection procedure is complete.
